Develop a business plan. (Contact the Business Development Bank of Canada, Coast Capital
Savings or the Canada/BC Service Centre)
Submit a name search for your company.
If you plan to operate as a sole proprietor or in a partnership, you must register your
company with the Registrar of Companies (At the Surrey Board of Trade) before the
expiry date.
If you plan to operate as a corporation, you must incorporate your company online at: regco.ca
before the expiry date.
Contact the By-Law Enforcement & Licensing Section and the Planning and
Development Department at the Surrey City Hall for the appropriate permits and
licenses. (604) 591-4370
Obtain the proper provincial and/or federal licenses.
All commercial businesses with more than \$30,000 in gross annual taxable sales and revenues
and/or you employ one or more people, obtain a business number (HST number) for remitting
employee's federal and provincial income tax deductions, employment insurance premiums and
Canada Pension Plan contributions from the Canada Revenue Agency (Call 1-800-959-5525).
Register your company with WCB by visiting their website at worksafebc.com
If you are hiring employees or subcontracting for labour, ensure that you comply with the pertinent
labour regulations by contacting the Employment Standards Branch of the
Ministry of Labour and Citizen Services (604) 660-2421
Contact a qualified accountant regarding setting up an orderly record and accounting system.
